



Waxed Paper Stained Glass Butterfly

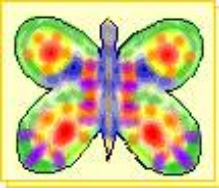
A simple-to-make butterfly window hanging.

Supplies needed:

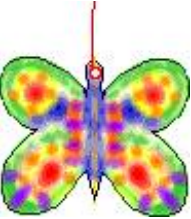
- Waxed paper
- Crayon shaving (crayons shaved with a scissors or a knife - by an adult)
- Scissors
- An iron
- Holepunch
- A few inches of string



	<p>Fold a piece of waxed paper in two. Draw half a butterfly with the body at the fold.</p>
	<p>Flip the paper over and draw the other half of the butterfly (using the original as your template).</p>
	<p>Open the waxed paper and put it on a flat surface.</p>
	<p>Put some crayon shavings on the waxed paper (and inside the butterfly).</p>



Cover the waxed paper with another piece of waxed paper. Have an adult iron the two layers of waxed paper together on low heat (protect your iron by putting a paper towel on top of the waxed paper while ironing).



Cut out the butterfly. Punch a hole near the top. Put a string in the hole for hanging it. This butterfly looks beautiful hanging in a window.
